



2016–2017 UNDERGRADUATE TUITION & FEES

Application/Registration

Application Fee: \$50.00 (non-refundable), for entrance to Seattle Bible College, to be sent along with completed application.

For international students there is **\$60.00 application fee and a \$100.00 processing fee** (non-refundable), to be sent along with completed application.

Registration Fee: \$50.00 (non-refundable), is assessed per student per quarter.

Tuition/Fees/Textbooks

Tuition: **\$1400.00** per quarter for students enrolled in 11-17 credits. Students enrolled in additional credits above 17 will be charged an additional **\$60.00** per credit.

(See reverse side for *F-1 Visa International Student* tuition information.)

All undergraduate students enrolled in less than 11 credits per quarter will be charged at the rate of **\$133.00** per credit.

General Student Fee (GSF): \$5.00 (non-refundable), per credit will be charged per quarter, with a maximum of \$50.00 per student per quarter.

Technology Fee: \$30.00 (non-refundable), charged per student per quarter.

Auditing Fee: \$50.00 (non-refundable), per audit hour required to audit a course. A **\$20.00 technology fee** per audit student per quarter is also assessed.

Textbooks, class notes and/or lab fees: will vary in cost from quarter to quarter. Students are to be prepared to order all textbooks on their own and pay for the quarter before attending classes.

Tuition Discounts

Pastoral/Missionary Discount: Applications for a ministerial discount for pastors, missionaries, their spouses and dependent children are available. Contact the SBC office for details.

Spousal discount: When a married student is enrolled full-time (minimum of 11 credits) at the College, there is a one-half (1/2) reduction in the standard academic tuition for the spouse (credit status).

Graduated Alumni Discount: A former student, who has graduated with an Associate of Biblical Studies or higher degree from SBC, is eligible to audit one course per quarter, on a space-available basis, at no tuition charge. That qualifying student will be charged only for the audit registration fee of **\$20.00**.

Miscellaneous

Deferred Payment Fee: \$50.00 (non-refundable), A deferred tuition plan *may* be available to approved students. If so, a processing fee will be charged to all students not paying their total quarterly bill for tuition and fees on or before *final registration* day for that quarter. The fee will be charged for each deferred payment plan approved per student over the course of the school year. A late fee is charged for late payments. Contact the SBC office for details.

Graduation Fee: \$150.00 is charged for each student graduating under any of the school's undergraduate programs (whether present for the graduation ceremony or not).

NOTE: All fees are non-refundable.
