## Admissions Instructions for International Students

- 1) Complete F-1 online application and questionnaire concerning spiritual life. Also include your response to spiritual questions found in the application, transcripts, spouse statement, etc. Website: www.seattlebiblecollege.edu
- 2) Pay online application fee along with completed application and all other documents if ready at time of application submission. If application fee cannot be paid online, you may pay the required fee by Western Union or in form of an International money order.
- 3) Submit an official copy of bank statement indicating sufficient funds to study at our school. US Government requires that all International Students are to have enough funds for the first year of study. This includes cost of tuition and living (housing, food, etc.) expenses. Financial documentation cannot be older than 3 months at time of application.
- 4) For 2022/2023, one year of tuition, fees and approx. housing costs for SBC is Undergraduate Studies program \$30,240 (single student); \$34,800 (married with family)
  For the Graduate Studies Program, tuition and fees are \$31,080 (single student); \$35,640 (married with family)
  - \*\* Please complete application, application fee and financial documentation as soon as possible to begin your admissions process. We cannot begin your admissions process without receiving these three documents first.
- 4) Submit an official (sealed) transcript of high school or college education records.
- 5) Submit three references (pastoral, personal and professional). References may be found on the website along with application. \*If a professional reference cannot be submitted, a second pastoral or personal reference may be considered as a substitute.
- 6) Submit copy of TOEFL test score or English proficiency equivalent.
- 7) Once all the above items have been received and verified, you will be scheduled for an official interview with the Dean of Seattle Bible College.
- 8) If admission to our College is approved, an official letter of acceptance will be created. After your I-20 is completed, you are required to pay the \$350.000 SEVIS fee online at: www.fmjfee.com
- 9) You will need to take your acceptance letter, I-20 form, proof of SEVIS payment and copy of all other documents that the embassy may require (contact the embassy for instructions).
- 10) The entire process listed above can take anywhere from 3-5 months.
- \*\* Please refer to all F-1 student-related information provided through Seattle Bible College.

## **SBC Approval**

Once admission to SBC is approved, student applicant is to make an arrangement for their personal interview at the closest US Embassy. Applicants must provide the following documents to the U.S. embassy or consulate at the time of application:

- Valid passport & I-20
- Official acceptance letter from Seattle Bible College
- Documented proof of financial support for at least one year
- Proof of SEVIS Fee payment (receipt)
- Visa application forms (available from the U.S. embassy/consulate)
- Any other documents required by your embassy/consulate
