2023– 2024 TUITION & FEES UNDERGRADUATE

Rates apply Winter Quarter 2024

Undergraduate Application Fee: \$50.00 (non-refundable) to be sent along with completed application.

Tuition: \$2,205 per quarter for students enrolled for 12 credits (full-time)

Students enrolled in less than 11 credits per quarter will be charged at the rate of **\$195.00** per credit.

Students enrolled in additional credits above 12-16 will be charged an additional **\$60.00** per credit.

Fees:

- **Registration Fee:** \$50.00 per quarter.
- **Technology Fee:** \$50.00 per quarter
- **General Student Fee:** \$50.00 per quarter (\$5 per credit, Max. \$50)
- **Deferred Payment Fee:** \$50.00 per quarter

A deferred tuition plan is available to all students who would like to pay tuition/fees in three payments rather than one lump sum each quarter.

- **Extension Fee:** \$100.00 for two weeks extension. *Dean Approval Required.*
- **Late Fee:** \$30.00 for payment 30 days late; \$60.00 for payment 60 days late
- **Auditing Fees:** \$120.00 per course

Textbooks/Class notes:

- Students are expected to order all textbooks on their own and pay for the textbook related expenses before the first day of class.
- There may be an additional charge for course notes which costs vary by course.

Tuition Discounts:

- **Pastoral/Missionary Discount:** Applications for a ministerial discount for pastors, missionaries, their spouses and dependent children are available. Contact the SBC office for details.
- **Spousal discount:** When a married student is enrolled full-time (minimum of 12 credits) at the College, there is a one-half (1/2) reduction in the standard academic tuition for the spouse (credit status).
- **Graduated Alumni Discount:** A former student, who has graduated with an Associate of Biblical Studies or higher degree from SBC, is eligible to audit courses at only \$60 per course.

Miscellaneous:

- **Graduation Fee: \$200.00** is charged for each student graduating under any of the school's Undergraduate programs (whether present for the graduation ceremony or not).

NOTE: All fees are non-refundable.

The regular academic school year operates on a quarterly system of three quarters per year. Programs consist of fall, winter, and spring quarters. Electives are offered in the summer quarter.

The tuition cost and fees are current as of the publication of this material. The College reserves the right to change the above schedule of tuition costs and fees at any time. Please contact the SBC office for any changes.
