#### **TH360/RBL630 Apologetics:**

**8:30 Prayer; 9:15--12:30 Class**

Apologetics helps the student consolidate a confident Christian worldview from which to defend the Christian faith against skepticism, criticism, and honest doubt, while sharing the power of the Gospel. Students will access tools for effectively engaging the culture and equipping others to do so.

#### **PT/GS120/RML690 The Listening Life: Discerning the Voice of God, Self, and Others:**

In this course students will practice listening in accompaniment with Jesus, the greatest listener of all time. Students will experience ways of listening to the Lord as they listen to the Word, the creation of God, their own interior selves, and to the souls of others. Students will gain skill in attuning to the voice of God in Scripture, nature, their own interior awareness, and that of others. Biblical, historical, and contemporary backgrounds will be given, providing the student with foundational tools for Spirit-led, Scripture centered attunement to how Christ is communing with them and with those they serve.
